***This past year has been especially tough for my son and his family. At the beginning of the pandemic, my son and daughter in law found out they were expecting their 4th child, due January 2021. Unfortunately, that happy moment in their life was overshadowed when one of their 4 year old sons began showing very concerning symptoms such as confusion, difficulty walking, and weight loss. They brought him to his doctor who immediately sent them to the nearest children's hospital where he was diagnosed with Type 1 Diabetes. They were then forced to shut down their online business, their only source of income during the summer months, to attend multiple appointments a week learning how to manage diabetic care for a 4 year old while also caring for their other 2 children. The father is a paraprofessional in a local school district, helping students within the special needs programs, so he does not work or receive income during the summer other than their online business. They struggled paying bills, buying their son's insulin and other diabetic prescriptions, not to mention the other miscellaneous expenses that come with having 3 children. Sadly they are still fighting to get out of the debt they accumulated during this time. Mom and Dad do whatever it takes to give their 3 boys everything they could ever need and work themselves to exhaustion giving them the best life possible, while shielding them from the real struggles they are all facing. They put family first and drop everything to help those in need, no matter the cost. This help would be a huge blessing to their family and I know they will pay it forward as soon as they are able.***
