



Statement of Understanding Regarding Breech Babies

When your baby is in the breech position close to birth it can be rather stressful. This statement is to make clear exactly what I am doing to help you.

As a chiropractor, I work to improve the function of muscles and bones. In your case, I am specifically focused on improving the function of the muscles and bones around your pelvis so that they can better accommodate the movements of the baby within. I do not manually or physically turn the baby. Manual turning of the baby is a medical procedure called the External Cephalic Version and is done by a medical practitioner usually in a hospital setting.

I will use soft tissue techniques (Uterine Release Technique) and Chiropractic Evaluation and Adjustments (The Webster Technique) to maximize pelvic function.
