

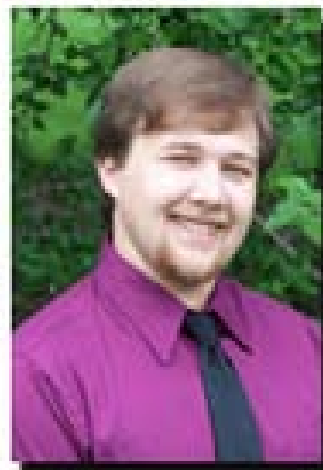

The Board of Directors of WikiChiro.org announces the official organization of the WikiChiro Foundation, created to provide a scientifically unbiased center for the public and for the profession to obtain the most current scientifically accurate information regarding the chiropractic profession and ultimately for complementary and alternative medicine as well. The Foundation will now incorporate in New Jersey, and file for 501 C(iii) status as a Charitable institution. WikiChiro, unlike Medpedia or WebMD will NOT accept advertisements or corporate money. And all editors will need to identify themselves, and reveal any conflicts of interest. Moreover, unlike WikiChiro, those medical sites only allow MD's and DO's to edit articles, and then presume to pontificate about these other professions.

The brainchild of Robert Press, MS, (Comp. Sci), soon to be Doctor Robert Press, and organized by his father, Dr. Stephen Press, of Englewood, NJ, WikiChiro.org already boasts many of the foremost scientists from around the world, working in research in the chiropractic sphere. Robert Press was elected to Chair the Technical Committee.

The WikiChiro concept was a result of barrage of scientifically biased and inaccurate statements about chiropractic and chiropractors found on Wikipedia, the end result of allowing Wikipedia's rules to be twisted to suit the agenda of the "*anti-everything alternative to drugs and surgery*" set. While it is true that information on Wikipedia in

the medical and surgical sphere is generally reasonably accurate, it is important to separate facts from obvious discrimination.

Elected Chairman of the WikiChiro Board, Dr. Robert Press is best known for being the founder of the Fédération Internationale de Chiropratique du Sport (FICS), known in English as the International Federation of Sports Chiropractic. FICS is the World Governing Body for the professional specialty of Sports Chiropractic. Organized in 1987 in London, FICS now represents over 100 national associations. Dr. Press was most recently honored at the World Congress of Chiropractic in Rio de Janeiro last month with the "FICS' Founder's Award". In the last few years, Dr. Press has become the Editor-in-Chief for Alternative medicine in WikiDoc.org, a Harvard Medical School based medical site, and is Executive Technical Director for OurMed.org, a similar site originated by a Columbia Medical School Professor.
